You are invited to offer public comment as outlined in this notice regarding proposed amendments to Chapter 4501:1-6 of the Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.) entitled "Registrars and Deputy Registrars."

You are receiving this message pursuant to the requirements of Executive Order 2011-011K and Senate Bill 2 of the 129th General Assembly, which require state agencies, including the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Motor Vehicles, to draft rules in collaboration with stakeholders, assess and justify any adverse impact on the business community (as defined by Senate Bill 2), and provide opportunity for interested parties to submit feedback regarding proposed rules.

The new rules are proposed as a result of House Bill 62 and impending House Bill 166.
